Greg Dickerson founded Human Supports of Idaho in 1996. Since that time, he has led the company through several efforts to improve the effectiveness and efficiency of the services the company provides. As an example, Human Supports of Idaho became the first private mental health agency in Idaho to earn a full 3 year accreditation award by CARE. The company has maintained full accreditation status since that initial award. Greg earned a bachelor degree in Social Work from Idaho State University, a Master of Social Work from the University of Denver, and a Master of Business Administration from Northwest Nazarene University. Throughout his career, Greg has served on several advisory boards, negotiated rulemaking processes, and participated in leadership forums designed to improve services for people with mental illnesses in Idaho. As an example, he has served in various roles on the Region 4 Mental Health Board (current known as the Region 4 Behavioral Health Board) since 2010. Greg is convinced that people with severe mental illness can and do recover from its effects and live full and meaningful lives.
